The Cavalier Award recognizes PA Students who have distinguished themselves within the "Cavalier Community" in the areas of service & academics.

Student Qualification Requirements

- Students must be in good standing with the faculty & administration of Princess Anne High School.
- Students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA, (Grade Point Average) for the 1st semester.
- Students must accumulate a minimum of 30 points to qualify.
- Maximum of 10 Pts. may be awarded by a sponsor for PAHS club activities.
- Maximum of 3 Pts. may be awarded by a teacher for a PAHS activity.
- All forms must be complete and verified by appropriate PAHS sponsors.
- VHSL Sanctioned activities may not be used for ECA's, Extra-Curricular Activity points.

Extra-Curricular Activities, ECA Point Values

(These are maximum Point Values per category!)

1 to 5 Points	=	Club Member or Committee Member
1 to 5 Points	=	Club Officer
5 Points	=	City-wide, State or National Honor/Award or position held
1 to 3 Points	=	Committee Chair or Leadership Position
1 to 5 Points	=	Student Helper (Office, Guidance, Library, Etc.)
3 Points	=	Student of the Month
5 Points	=	Student of the Quarter
1 to 5 Points	=	Other contributions to PAHS, verified by PAHS Faculty Sponsor

Teachers & Sponsors must utilize the point values assigned above for awarding points.
Teachers & Sponsors may award & verify points only for PAHS activities that they are directly responsible for.
Teachers may award a maximum of 3 Total Points for a student's participation in a PAHS activity.
Sponsors may award a maximum of 10 Total Points for a student's participation in a PAHS club.

General Information:

- ✓ ADD (Service/Activity Points) + (GPA Equivalent Points) = Total Points (Minimum of 30 total points needed to Qualify)
- ✓ VHSL Sanctioned activities cannot be used for the Cavalier Award; these activities include the School Newspaper, Debate, Forensics, Literary Magazine, Cheerleaders, JV & Varsity Team Sports. (*VHSL Activities that award school letters may not be used.*)
- ✓ A School Letter and a Pin will be awarded to first time qualifiers, Stars & Bars will be awarded to award veterans.
- ✓ Only PAHS Staff & Faculty members may verify participation and only PAHS related activities for this school year may be used for this award.
- ✓ Award Recipients names will be posted on-line in "PAHS- Scholarships" website & E-mailed to all PA staff & faculty.
- ✓ ALL Recipients will receive written invitations to the "PA Award Program" thru Homerooms, recipients families are also invited to attend.
- ✓ All applications must have PAHS Service/Activity Sponsor/s Signature/s to validate your service. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
- ✓ Attach a copy of your most recent report card.
- ✓ Cavalier Awards will be presented at the "PA Award Program", 4th Block in the auditorium on Wednesday, March 26, 2014.
