ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- ❖ Be graduating from any fully accredited high school.
- ❖ Have been enrolled at KLMS for at least 2 full academic years, and departed KLMS in good standing.
- ❖ Matriculate at a fully accredited college, university or vocational/technical by fall 2013.
- ❖ Have maintained at least an overall high school grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. KLMS Scholarship Application
2. Official sealed copy of the applicant's H.S. academic transcript.
3. Two letters of recommendation
 - o One teacher recommendation
 - o One community recommendation (*not a family member*)
4. List of current extracurricular, personal, community involvements or work experience (*KLMS and high school*)
5. List of awards and honors received (*KLMS and high school*)
6. Personal Essay

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION Application packets must be received at KLMS *on or before 3:00 pm, Thursday, April 18, 2013.*

- ❖ Submit the complete, accurate and legible application form and all accompanying documents to the KLMS PTA Scholarship Committee. PTA is not responsible for entries that are incomplete, may be lost, late or have postage due. Please keep a copy for your records. Applications should be submitted by VBCPS interdepartmental mail system, U.S. mail or hand delivered in a sealed envelope to:

- ❖ The scholarship check will be made payable to the college, university or vocational/technical school where the recipient matriculates. It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to notify **Debbie O'Connell, KLMS PTA Treasurer**, of the student ID#, the name of the institution and the address where the payment should be made.
- ❖ Awards will be announced and presented with the check at the awards ceremonies at the recipients' respective local High School, otherwise, they can be mailed to the recipient's address if recipient does not attend the ceremony.

Selection Criteria: Academic achievement, extracurricular, civic or community involvements, thoughtful and meaningful essays.
